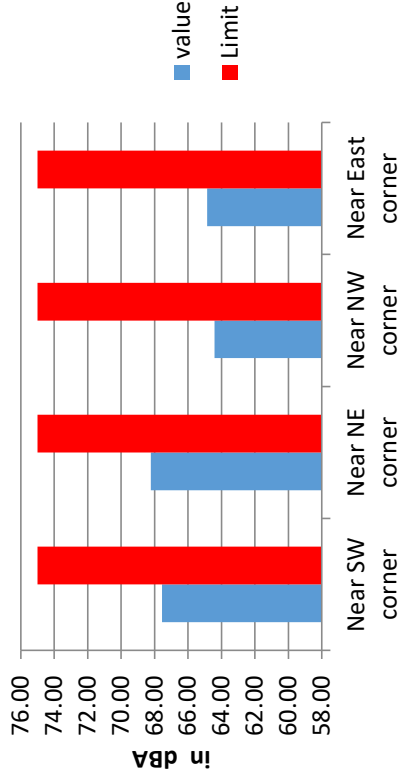

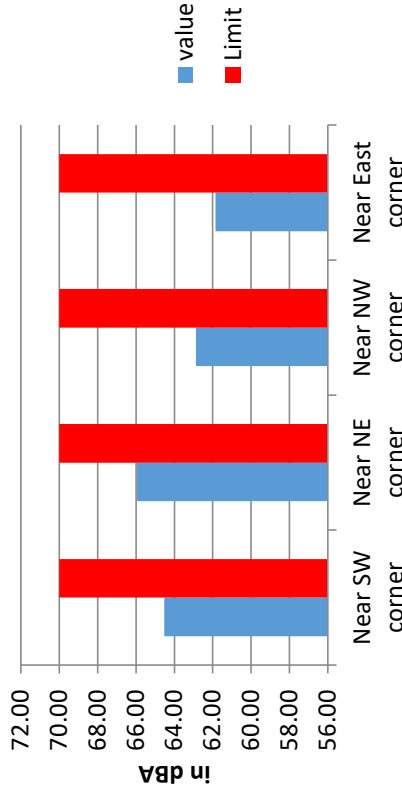

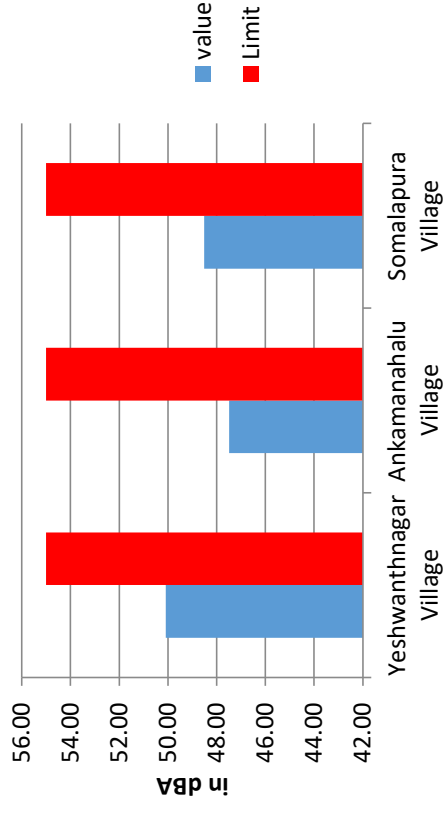
Ambient Noise (Industrial area)-

Night time



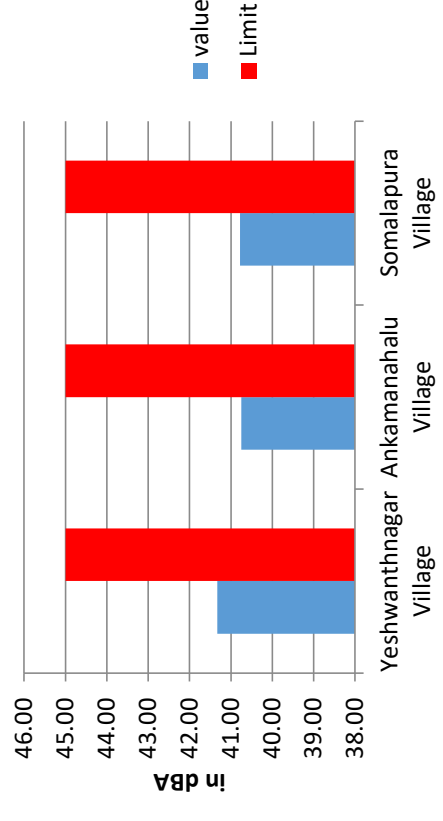
